Please check your ticket carefully to ensure that it is for the correct date, time and number of passengers. Train departure times are shown as 10.30, 12.00, 13.30 and 15.00 under the date.

We regret that when a train is fully booked, it may not be possible to make additions to a booking; we reserve the right to make an administration charge of £5 for any amendments.

We hope that the information in this leaflet will help you get the most out of your visit.

TRAIN DEPARTURE TIMES

You should aim to reach the station at least 20 minutes before your scheduled departure time. Your ticket is only valid for the date and departure time that is printed on it.

Please check for traffic disruption before you travel, as we regret we cannot hold trains

beyond their booked departure time.

FINDING YOUR SEAT

Seats have been reserved for you in the coach indicated on your ticket. After the announcement that the train is ready for boarding, please enter the coach allocated to you. Coach A is at the front of the train nearest the footbridge.

To find your seats, look at the reservation labels on the tables. These show the names in which bookings were made.

Please remember that infants travelling free (17 months and under) are not allocated a seat, but will receive a present from Santa. If you have any difficulty finding your seat, please speak to the coach steward.

TOILETS

Toilets and baby changing facilities are available at Bo'ness Station and the Museum of Scottish Railways. Emergency toilet facilities are available on the train and at Birkhill Station.

WHEELCHAIRS AND BUGGIES

Passengers using wheelchairs and their party should be seated in Coach B which has a ramped access. If you require any assistance please let us know.

For safety reasons, emergency exits must be kept clear. This means there is no facility for storing buggies on board the train. Limited facilities are available for keeping buggies at Bo'ness Station. Please note the Buggy Park is unsupervised and items are left at owner's risk.

Please note that details may change owing to operational requirements or weather conditions.
