The TV adaptation of author Diana Gabaldon's *Outlander* was filmed entirely on location in Scotland including at our very own Bo'ness Station which was transformed to double as a wartime London railway station where two of the main characters, Claire and Frank, say their goodbyes.

The train used for the filming consisted of locomotive Morayshire hauling some of our teak 1930s coaches which are housed in our Reserve Collection Building.
